EXPERIMENTAL SHOULDER-PEAK RIDER

AVAILABILITY

(C)

This Rider is available only to locations now served hereunder and to locations for which definite rate commitments have been made as of December 31, 1998 for Customers upon executed agreement, on General Power Service Schedule 30, or Primary Power Service Schedules 40, 41, 44 or 46 when in Company's sole judgment, adequate electrical facilities are in place to serve Customer. For purposes of this Rider, the shoulder-peak hours for the month of April and May shall include the hours from 7:00 a.m. to 9 a.m. and from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday. Shoulder-peak hours for the months of June through September shall include the hours from 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 Noon, and from 8:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday. Customers must contract in advance for capacity under this Rider. The capacity contracted for in excess of on-peak demand under this Rider shall be scheduled (in kilowatts (kW) or kilovolt-Amperes (kVA) to conform with applicable rate schedule) at a minimum level of 3,000 kVA or kW. The shoulder-peak capacity in excess of the on-peak capacity is subject to interruption for emergency and maintenance purposes and for generation and transmission deficiencies and peak shaving upon not less than two (2) hours notice.

Subject to availability determined solely by the Company, the shoulder-peak hours for the months of January, February, March, October, November and December include the hours 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday. The shoulder-peak capacity in excess of on-peak demand is subject to interruption for any purpose upon a minimum one (1) hour notice for these six months only. Company may withdraw the shoulder peak designation for any day or days during these six months and will attempt to give the Customers at least 14 hours notice of such withdrawal.

Loads not interrupted upon such notice will be counted as on-peak load under standard provisions of the rate schedule serving Customer. This Rider may be withdrawn upon 30 days written notice to Customers contracting service under this Rider.

MONTHLY RATE

Shoulder-Peak Demand Effects.

For Customers taking service under this experimental Rider, the on-peak period shall be as defined in the rate schedule but shall exclude the shoulder-peak hours as contained herein. For such service, the billing demand for the period shall be the on peak demand plus the greater of either 25% of the excess of the maximum shoulder-peak demand over such on-peak demand, or the off-peak demand billing provision stated in the rate schedule. The instantaneous provision for the shoulder-peak period shall be calculated in the same manner as defined in the rate schedule. In no case shall the billing demand be less than the demand provisions listed in the rate schedule.

Energy Charge.

Energy consumed under the provisions of this Rider shall be included in the energy billing in accordance with the applicable rate schedule.
